



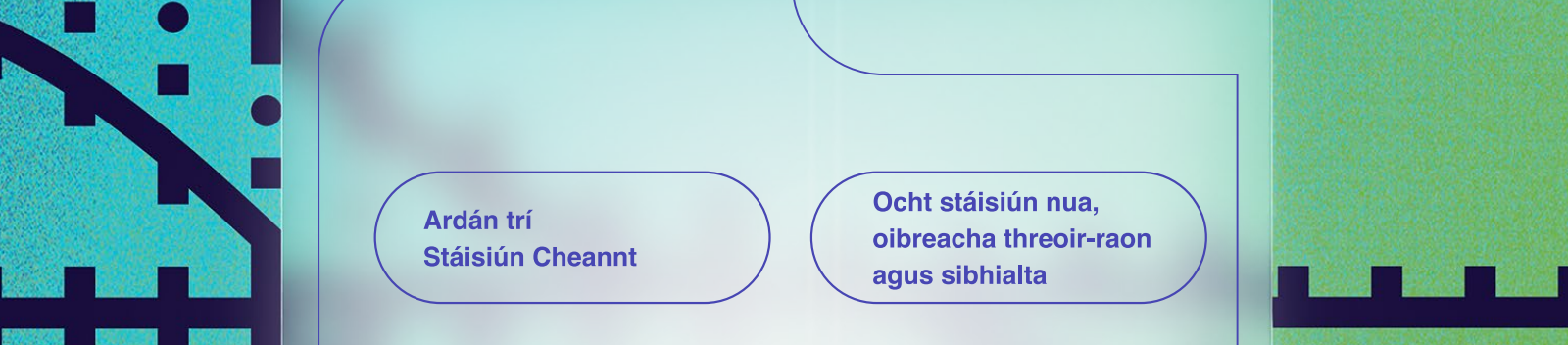
Nuachtlitir is deireanaí maidir le Iarnród Comaitéireachta Cheantar Chorcaí

Tá ríméad orainn an nuacht is deireanaí maidir le dul chun cinn Iarnród Comaitéireachta Cheantar Chorcaí, an clár feabhsúcháin iarnróid bunathraitheach do ghreásán Iarnród Chorcaí, a chur ar fáil. Ní hamháin go gcuirfidh an tionscadal seo le mínicíocht agus le hacmhainn traenach ach táógáid sé freisin leis an aistriú i dtreo córas iompair níos inbhuanaithe agus nasctha don chathair.

Cúlra ar an gClár

Is é Iarnród Comaitéireachta Cheantar Chorcaí, atá mar chuid d'fhís **CMATS**, an infheistíocht iarnróid is mó riamh i gCorcaigh, a bhfuil sé mar aidhm aici contae níos iomaíche agus níos inbhuanaithe a chruthú trí roghanna iompair éifeachtúla a sholáthar agus taisteal cothrom, tíosach ar fhuinneamh a spreagadh.

Trí mhínicíocht agus acmhainn traenach a threisiú, tá sé mar aidhm ag an gclár 16 milliún turas paisinéirí a sholáthar gach bliain agus seirbhís iarnróid ar ardminicíocht a sholáthar a nasctha pobail agus a laghdaíonn spleáchas ar charranna.

Uasdhátú maidir leis an gClár

Ardán trí Stáisiún Cheannt a thógáil

Is é sin ardán dhá thaobh chun ardán 6 a shíneadh i Stáisiún Cheannt faoi lán seoil. Nuair a bheid sé sin curtha i gcrích, ligfidh sé seo do thraenacha dul tríd an stáisiún gan dualgas a chur ar pháisnéirí athrú ó na traenacha ar a mbeidh siad. Tá na hoibreacha ag dul ar aghaidh de réir an sceidil agus táthar ag súil go mbeidh siad curtha i gcrích roimh dheireadh 2024.

Dhá rian a chur ar fáil idir An Gleanntán agus Mainistir na Corann

I mí Mheán Fómhair 2024, cuireadh tús leis an tógáil dhá rian a chur ar an líne 10km go hiomlán. Meastar go dtógfaidh sé thart ar 18 mí, agus go gcuirfear é i gcrích in 2026.

Comharthaíocht & Cumarsáid a Uasghrádú

Tá uasghrádú mór comharthaíochta ar bun chun tacú le líon na traenacha atá ag feidhmiú idir Corcaigh agus an Cóbh, Mainistir na Corann agus Mala a mhéadú faoi thri.

Stáisiún Nua, Iosta Nua Flit agus Leictriú

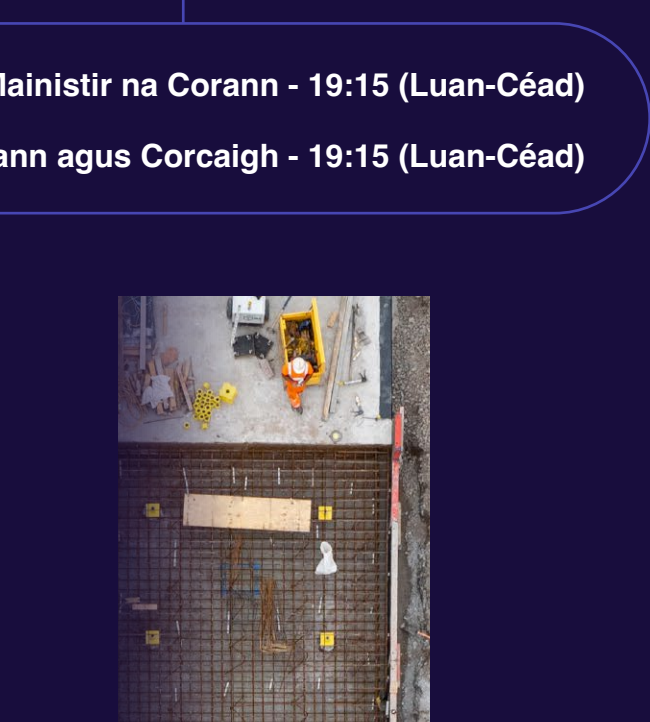
Tá forbairt deiridh ar siúl faoi láthair le haghaidh ocht stáisiún nua i bpríomhláithreáin, iosta nua flit agus leictriú an ghreásáin iarnróid comaitéireachta.

Éascóidh an infheistíocht comharthaíochta ina iomláine seo na méaduithe acmhainne agus minicíochta seirbhíse atá beartaíte agus cuideoidh sí le hiontaofacht an chórais comharthaíochta a fheabhsú.

Reachtálfar comhairliúcháin phoiblí in 2025 chun a chinntiú go mbeidh aiseolas ón bpobal cuimsithe sna dearaí.

Oibreacha atá le teacht

Mar chuid den chlár, beidh oibreacha san oíche idir lámha ag foirne ar fud ghreásán Chorcaí as seo go deireadh na bliana.

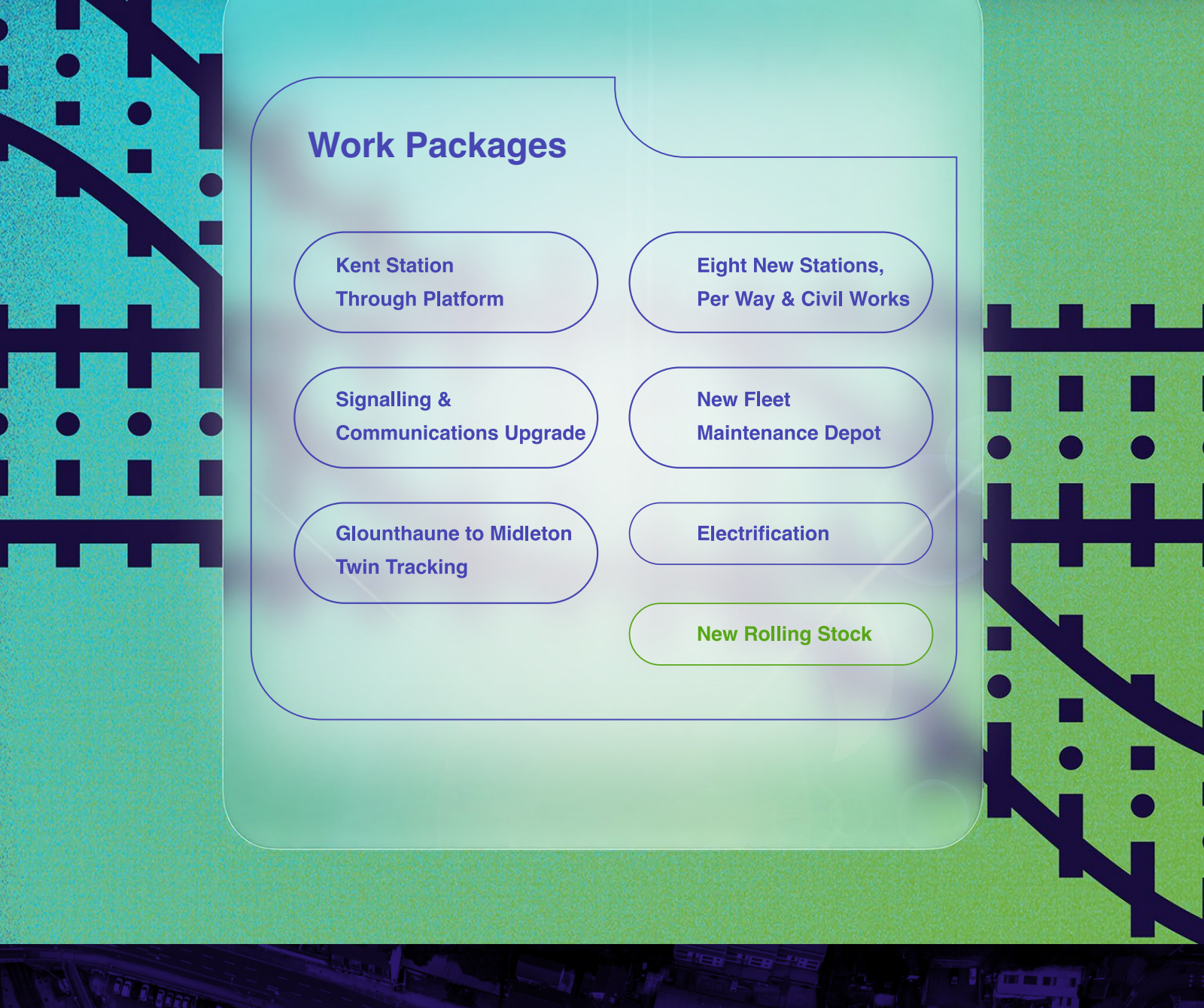
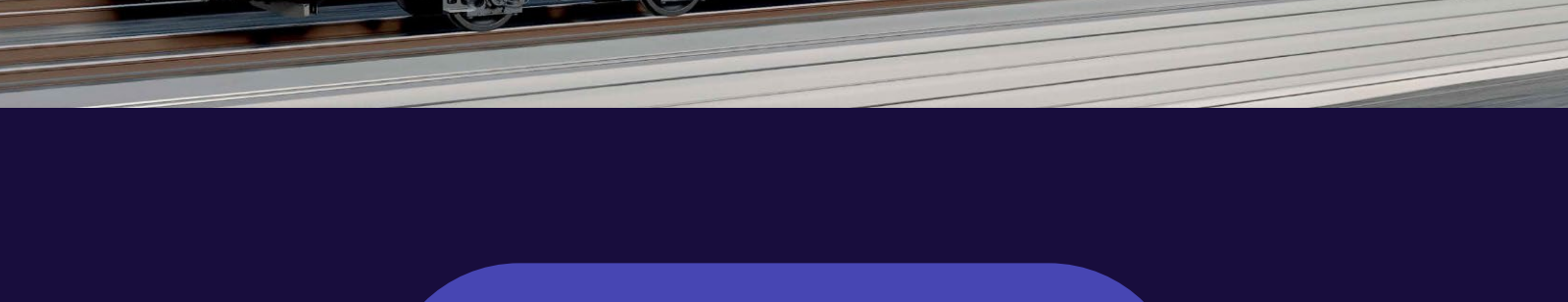

Newsletter Update for Cork Area Commuter Rail

We are delighted to provide the latest updates on the programme of Cork Area Commuter Rail, a transformative rail improvement programme for the Cork rail network. This project will not only enhance train frequency and capacity but will also support the shift towards a more sustainable and connected transport system for the city.

Background on the Programme

The Cork Area Commuter Rail, part of the **CMATS** vision, is Cork's largest-ever rail investment, aiming to create a more competitive and sustainable county by providing efficient transport options and encouraging balanced, energy-efficient travel.

By boosting train frequency and capacity, the programme aims to deliver 16 million passenger journeys annually and provide a high-frequency rail service that connects communities and reduces car dependency.



The programme consists of several key work packages, each addressing a crucial component of the overall transformation:

- Kent Station Through Platform
- Signalling & Communications Upgrade
- Glounthaune to Midleton Twin Tracking
- Eight New Stations, Per Way & Civil Works
- New Fleet Maintenance Depot
- Electrification
- New Rolling Stock

Programme Update

Kent Station Through Platform

Construction of the double-sided Platform 6 extension at Kent Station is well underway.

This project aims to allow trains to pass through the station without requiring passengers to change services. The works are progressing on schedule and are expected to be completed by the end of 2024.

Glounthaune to Midleton Twin Track

Construction to fully twin track the 10km line has commenced in September 2024. It is expected to take approximately 18 months, with completion in 2026.

Signalling & Communications Upgrade

A major signalling upgrade is underway to support a tripling of the number of trains operating between Cork and Cobh, Midleton and Malinbeg.

This overall signalling investment will facilitate the proposed capacity and service frequency increases and help improve the reliability and safety of the signalling system and the service on our network.

New Stations, Fleet Depot, and Electrification

Design development is ongoing for eight new stations, upgrade of existing stations, a new rail fleet depot, and the electrification of the commuter rail network.

Public consultations will be held in 2025 to ensure community feedback is integrated into the designs.

Upcoming Works

To ensure the progress of the works, we will need to work day and night, including some weekends. We apologise in advance for any inconvenience this may cause, but these efforts are essential to ensure the enhancements progress timely.

We have commenced significant works as part of the Glounthaune to Midleton Twin Track (GMTT) project. These will affect some evening services between Cork and Midleton.

The changes are scheduled as follows:

Final train from Cork to Midleton - 19:15hrs (Mon-Wed)
 Final train from Midleton to Cork - 19:45hrs (Mon-Wed)

Bus transfers will operate between Glounthaune and Midleton for later evening services.

As part of the programme, our teams will be carrying out nighttime works across the Cork network from now until the end of the year.

We will make every effort to notify you by letter if there are noisy night-time works scheduled in your area.
